God has blessed Trinity Baptist church with this retreat and we are glad to share our facilities with your group. We would much rather have our things wear out from good use, than to let them sit unused. We would ask that you keep in mind the following simple guidelines that will help us and you to use these facilities to the fullest.

All use of this cabin is subject to the guidelines of Trinity Wilderness Retreat (TWR). Please be sure you are familiar with these guidelines before planning your activities.

The kitchen is equipped with basic necessities for your use. Before using the appliances however, familiarize yourself with their proper operation. You are welcome to use any of the pans, utensils, etc... that you wish, but you should do so with the understanding that any of these items which are lost or damaged will be replaced at your expense. (**see attached list)

Before checking out of the cabin, all floors, counter surfaces, bathroom areas, wastebaskets, and fireplace (if used) should be thoroughly cleaned and all waste disposed of as you leave the camp. Dishes and kitchen utensils should be washed and placed in proper locations. Appliances should be cleaned, and all food items should be removed from the cabin when you leave.

When it is time to leave the TWR Manager will meet you at the prearranged time to check the status of the cabin and go through all the checkout procedures.

Since the Trinity Wilderness Retreat is a distinctly Christian atmosphere, the New Testament principle of modesty should always be the standard for dress on the property. It is the responsibility of the sponsors from each church to give each camper a list of the dress code BEFORE they come to camp and for the sponsors to meet with the parents to make sure the dress codes are understood. We suggest that sponsors should model the standard and enforce the camp dress code.

While on the TWR grounds, campers may not wear tank tops, apparel that exposes the midriff, or extremely tight fitting clothing. Apparel may not display or promote tobacco, alcohol, controlled substances or inappropriate language and any other unbecoming behavior. Any of these actions will result in an immediate forfeit of deposit and depending on the severity of the offense, the one responsible or the entire group may be required to leave the camp site as well.

In addition, alcoholic beverages will not be allowed on any of the church premises at any time. No pets are allowed inside any of the facilities at anytime (exception: aid dogs). No dancing allowed on any of the church premises. Children must be supervised at all times by a responsible adult (age 21 or older). Smoking is not allowed on premises.

Further, Trinity Wilderness Retreat will in no way be responsible for loss or damage to personal property of individuals staying or visiting the property. TWR will not be responsible for injury to any individual on the premises.

Kitchen Policies:

1. All open food items are to be put into a zip lock bag or a sealed container before storing.
2. No Open containers, or Styrofoam cups are to be left in the refrigerators.
3. No food is to be left on the kitchen counters, sealed or unsealed.
4. The kitchen is not a storage area for non-kitchen items.
5. Any supplies that are near depletion should be listed and the TWR Manager notified at check-out time.
6. All utensils should be returned cleaned to their proper place.
7. Stove, oven, deep fryer, sinks and tables must be cleaned at check-out time.
8. Refrigerators and freezer must be empty and wiped out at check-out time.
9. If you use the kitchen put everything back according to these policies.
10. Any problems, or supplies needed, should be brought to the attention of the TWR Manager.

Cleaning Policies:

1. Clean off vanities in all bathrooms, empty trash and sweep.
2. Clean commodes inside and out.
3. Clean showers and wipe down.
4. Sweep all floors
5. Mop down stairs and all bathrooms. Mop floors upstairs around and under bunks where necessary.
6. Use broom on outside entrances.
7. Pick up all trash outside the building.
8. Tables and chairs are to be cleaned and returned to where they were located.
9. Take all trash out to the green boxes on the Highway on a regular basis or when you leave.

Fireplace Instructions:

1. No cutting of timber on the property
2. All ashes must be cleaned out of the fireplace upon departure.

Emergency Procedures:

FIRE ESCAPES are to be used in the event the stairs are not safe to descend. The FIRE ESCAPES are located up stairs in both sleeping areas, through a window marked 'EMERGENCY EXIT'. The route to this window is marked with florescent tape and should be open at all times. To exit, the window should be opened as wide as possible, the steps on the escape should be released, and the individuals should descend one at a time, preferably, the most able bodied first. It is recommended that you have a mock drill the first day you arrive.

FIRE EXTINGUISHERS are located through out the building and are marked with signs. It is recommended that one person be designated to be responsible for use if necessary, however, all adults should be familiar with their use.

EXIT Doors and passageways are marked with battery powered lights that will illuminate in the event the electricity is interrupted.
